22-08 Classic Workshop LLC - B 1202 L 4, 1620 Route 57 - Use Variance/Site Plan Waiver
Attorney Lowcher stated the property which is currently improved by a multi-tenant building which was approved by the Board in 1989. He noted that Classic Workshop is proposing a public garage which is a condition use in this $\mathrm{B}-1$ with no changes being made. The only condition not being met is it requires two driveways but only one was approved originally. All of the information required for a Site Plan is contained in the original approval and a survey.

Attorney Bryce further advised that we should not be discussing the merits of this given the potential for it to come back to the Board for some kind of approval. No official action can be taken by the Board but individual citizens can communicate to the Class I and Class III Committee representatives, to pass along to the Township Committee meeting tomorrow night, to incorporate into any response they may be sending to SWAC.
