**Free Town-Wide Shredding Event**: October 19, 2019, from 9:00 am to 12 noon at the Department of Public Works Garage located at 1710 Route 57. Papers should be loose and dry – no rubber bands, binders, metal fasteners, hanging folders, metal book rings or binder clips.

**TV/Electronics Recycling Coming Soon**: Warren County Pollution Control Financing Authority is still waiting for the necessary materials from the vendor prior to commencing with the collection of TV's and electronics.

**Trex**: Mrs. Fascenelli advised that the collection of bag and film recycling will begin August 1, 2019 through February 1, 2020. Materials will be weighed and delivered to Weis Markets once a month by a Green Team member. Also, once a month the number of pounds recycled must be reported to Trex. The Township received two (2) bins for collection. One is placed at the Municipal Building and second location will be determined at a later date. The following clean, dry, empty plastic bags and film packaging is acceptable:

LDPE / HDPE Films Pellet Bags

Newspaper Sleeves Produce Bags

Bread Bags Dry Cleaning Bags

Product Wrap Grocery Bags

Cereal Liners Case Overwrap

Food Storage Bags Packaging Air Pillows

Ice Bags Salt Bags

Your plastic bags and wraps then become Earth-friendly composite decking and railing! The goal is to collect 500 pounds in a 6 month time frame in order for the Township to receive a free Trex park bench. The most important goal is to keep the above materials out of the landfill.

Ms. Todd will distribute flyers to the local stores. Mrs. Fascenelli will forward information to the Fire Companies.
