

### I want to have a Raffle, What do I do?

First: Every non-profit organization desiring to apply for a license to conduct bingo or raffles must register with the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission (LGCCC). Registration from the LGCCC is valid for two years.

**THIRD:** Submit your application to the Township Clerk, at least 5 weeks prior to the event, in quadruplicate, accompanied by the required fees. Each copy must have original signatures on the last page and an original notary seal.

#### **DISCLAIMER**

This packet is meant to be used a guide. NJ Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission has full authority over games of chance.

# Types of Raffles and Fees OFF-PREMISES 50/50 DRAW RAFFLE

Raffle Tickets are sold PRIOR to the date that winning ticket is pulled. 50% of the proceeds are awarded to the winning ticket. Sample ticket is required for this type of raffle.

State Fee: \$20 each day on which a drawing(s) is to be conducted.

**Additional Fee**: \$20 for each \$1,000 or part thereof in value of the awarded prize(s) in excess of \$1,000 shall be forwarded to the state by check payable to the Commission together with the Report of Operations as required by N.J.A.C. 13:47-9

#### ON-PREMISES 50/50 DRAW RAFFLE

Raffle tickets are sold only at the event. 50% of the proceeds are awarded to the winning ticket. No sample ticket is required for this type of raffle. **State Fee:** Flat fee of \$20 for each day ONLY IF ANTICIPATED PRIZE IS IN EXCESS OF \$400, otherwise fee is \$0

#### OFF-PREMISES MECHANDISE DRAW RAFFLE

Raffle Tickets are sold PRIOR to the date that winning ticket is pulled. The winnings are goods designated by the organization with a monetary value (NO CASH). Examples: quilts, gift baskets, gift cards, electronics, vehicles, sporting event tickets, etc. Sample ticket is required for this type of raffle. **State Fee:** \$20.00 for each \$1,000 or part thereof of the total retail value of the prize to be awarded.

#### ON-PREMISE MECHANDISE DRAW RAFFLE

Raffle tickets are sold only at the event. The winnings are goods designated by the organization with a monetary value (NO CASH). Examples: quilts, gift baskets, gift cards, electronics, vehicles, sporting event tickets, etc. No sample ticket is required for this type of raffle. **State Fee:** Flat fee of \$20 for each day ONLY IF ANTICIPATED PRIZE IS IN EXCESS OF \$400, otherwise fee is \$0

#### **INSTANT RAFFLE GAME (PULL TABS)**

Pull tab tickets are much like instant lottery tickets. The object of the game is to open the perforated windows on the back of the ticket and match the symbols inside the ticket to the winning combinations on the front of the ticket. The winning pull tab ticket is turned ir for a monetary prize. **State Fee:** \$20.00 for each day on which instant raffle tickets are sold or offered for sale, or \$750.00 for a one-year license to sell, or to offer for sale, instant raffle tickets during that year.

#### **CALENDAR RAFFLE**

Off-premise draw raffle in which calendars bearing nonrepeating consecutive numbers are sold. A specific cash or merchandise prize is designated for each date on the calendar upon which a prize is to be awarded. The winners are determined by drawing from a container, objects bearing numbers matching the non-repeating numbers on all calendars sold. A calendar raffle shall not be conducted more often than twice in any calendar year. Maximum prize amount, not to exceed \$25,000.00. Sample ticket is required for this type of raffle. **State Fee:** \$20.00 for each \$1,000.00 or part thereof of the total retail value of the prize to be awarded.

#### **NON-DRAW RAFFLE- CARNIVAL GAMES**

Game or Wheel of Chance **State Fee:** \$20.00 for each game or wheel on any day, or any series of days not exceeding six at one location

This is not a complete list of raffles, but the most common.

#### Raffle Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. How do I register with the Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission?
  - Complete an Initial Affidavit and Application for Biennial Registration, found on the NJ Legalized Games of Chance Control Commission website: <a href="https://www.njconsumeraffairs.gov/lgccc/applications/initial-affidavit-and-application-for-biennial-registration.pdf">https://www.njconsumeraffairs.gov/lgccc/applications/initial-affidavit-and-application-for-biennial-registration.pdf</a>
  - Definition of terms "Qualified organization" means a bona fide organization or association of veterans, religious congregation, religious organization, charitable organization, educational organization, fraternal organization, civic and service club, officially recognized fire company, first aid squad, or rescue squad
- 2. Where do I apply for each game of chance?
  - You must apply in the town where the games are to be held or the winner will be drawn
  - · Each game must be individually applied for.
  - There are no "blanket licenses"
- 3. Can I apply for a game of chance if my LGCCC registration has expired?
  - No, a copy of the valid registration must be submitted with the application.
  - Registration must be valid through the date of the raffle in order for the application to be received by the office.
- 4. Does my application need to be notarized?
  - Yes, applications need to be submitted in quadruplicate with original signatures notarized.
- 5. Can I give 1 application to the Township of Mansfield to make copies?
  - No, since the signatures and notary must be original, copies of a single application cannot be made or accepted.
- 6. What is the difference between On and Off Premise games of chance?
  - On Premise means the winner of the prize needs to be present.
  - Off Premise means the winner of the prize does not need to be present, Sample tickets ALWAYS need to be provided if off premise
- 7. What needs to be provided on a Sample Ticket?
  - NJ LGCCC Registration Id number
  - Name of Organization: must match exactly what is on the Registration Card of the Organization Card issued from the LGCCC
  - Description of Prize and Value
  - Location of Drawing
  - Date of Drawing
  - Price of Ticket
  - Purpose to which proceeds will be devoted
  - Space for the municipality issued Raffle License No.
  - Space for the purchaser's information
- 8. When do I need to provide a Sample Ticket?
  - Sample tickets must be included when submitting an Off Premise Game of Chance Application.

- 9. How long do I need to hand in the application in order for my raffle to be accepted?
  - The Township of Mansfield requests that applications are submitted at least five (5) weeks prior to a game of chance's date of operation. The NJ LGCCC requires a minimum of 14 days from the receipt of application in Trenton before approving a raffle. If a holiday, unexpected closing, etc. occurs in this time, this timeline may be extended. It is important to get the application in as early as possible so that if an error is present, it can be corrected without affecting the date of the raffle.
- 10. My application was rejected, who do I speak to?
  - The municipality where you applied can be contacted to assist in correcting an application. The
    denial of an application always comes from the State. The State has the ultimate deciding power
    on whether an application is approved. The rejection letter from the State will have a contact
    number listed.
- 11. What is the Report of Operations?
  - The report of operations is a form that needs to be completed and submitted to the State.
  - The form may require additional fees based on the value of the prizes or proceeds raised.
  - Must be submitted to the STATE no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the calendar month following the date
    of the licensed activity.
- 12. Can I change the date of my game?
  - Yes, an application to amend a raffle license must be completed.

## **Prohibited Prizes**

#### No licensee shall offer or award any prize consisting of:

- Real estate or any interest therein
- Bonds
- Shares of stock
- Securities or evidences of indebtedness
- Weapons
- Live animals (except a gift certificate redeemable for live, edible seafood)
- Foreign or domestic coins (except collector pieces or sets that are marketed as such and are clearly not intended for use as legal tender)
- Tobacco products
- Motor vehicle leases
- Any merchandise refundable in any of the foregoing or as money
- Cash money, unless it's a 50/50

# When do I need to provide a sample ticket?

Off-Premises raffles require a sample ticket. Sample tickets are to be submitted on forms prescribed by the LGCCC.

**OFF-PREMISES RAFFLE AWARDING CASH OR MONEY AS A PRIZE -** "Off-premises 50-50 raffle" means a raffle conducted by a drawing for a cash or money prize or prizes, with respect to which tickets may be sold in advance of the occasion of the drawing and the winner(s) need not be present to win, the prize or prizes equaling 50 percent of the amount received for all tickets or rights to participate.

When tickets are sold for an off-premise raffle awarding cash or money as a prize, each ticket shall contain at least the following information:

Name and identification number of the qualified organization and number of the license issued for the occasion
Place where the occasion will be held and the date and time thereof;
The statement: "This is a 50/50 cash raffle and the winner will receive 50 percent of the amount received for all
tickets or rights to participate";
If the prize pool is to be divided among multiple winners, the ticket must indicate the percentage of the prize
pool that each winner will receive;
The number of the ticket;
Price of the ticket;
The purpose to which the entire net proceeds will be devoted; and
The statement: "No substitution of the offered prize may be made."

The presence of the holder of a ticket shall not be required in order to win unless the ticket bears the statement "NOT VALID UNLESS HOLDER IS PRESENT AT THE DRAWING."

☐ The stub of each ticket shall bear the name and address of the holder, the number of the ticket, the raffle license issued for the occasion and the identification of the licensed organization.

## Did you know?

#### **CHINESE AUCTION**

A Chinese auction is a combination of a <u>raffle</u> and an <u>auction</u> that is typically featured at charity, church festival and numerous other events. Can also be known as **penny social**, **tricky tray** or **pick-a-prize** according to local custom, or to avoid any reference to nationality.

The difference between a raffle and a Chinese auction is that in a raffle with multiple prizes, there is one "hat" from which names are drawn, but in a Chinese auction each prize has its own "hat". This allows ticket buyers to choose which prize to focus on, as opposed to having a first, second, third, etc. prize.

In a Chinese auction, bidders are not prospective buyers. Instead, they buy tickets, which are chances to win items. The tickets themselves are often as inexpensive as a penny, and bidders may buy hundreds of these tickets. Bidders buy as many tickets as they like, and bid them on any item(s) they want by placing one or more ticket in the "hat" beside the item(s) they are trying to win. At the conclusion of bidding, one winning ticket is drawn from the "hat" beside each item, and the item is given to the owner of that ticket.

- Applicant must apply for a license.
- If prizes are under \$400, there is no charge for the raffle license.
- Value of prizes must be stated or if unknown, whether prizes will exceed \$400. If prizes are unknown, the applicant must write that the organization will not award any prohibited prizes such as cash, lottery tickets, tobacco, weapons, etc.
- Generic-type tickets are acceptable for Chinese Auction

#### SILENT AUCTION

**Silent auction** is a variant of the English auction in which bids are written on a sheet of paper. At the predetermined end of the auction, the highest listed bidder wins the item. This auction is often used in charity events, with many items auctioned simultaneously and "closed" at a common finish time. The auction is "silent" in that there is no auctioneer selling individual items, the bidders writing their bids on a bidding sheet often left on a table near the item. At charity auctions, bid sheets usually have a fixed starting amount, predetermined bid increments, and a "guaranteed bid" amount which works the same as a "buy now" amount. Other variations of this type of auction may include sealed bids. The highest bidder pays the price he or she submitted.

• These auctions do not require a raffle license since there is no charge to play.

**CALENDAR RAFFLE** - "Calendar raffle" means an off-premises draw raffle in which calendars bearing nonrepeating consecutive numbers are sold. A specific cash or merchandise prize is designated for each date on the calendar upon which a prize(s) is to be awarded. The winners are determined by drawing from a container, objects bearing numbers matching the non-repeating numbers on all calendars sold.

Each player shall be provided with a ticket printed in a calendar format which shall clearly and conspicuously contain at least the following information:

54	The name and identification number of the qualified organization and number of the license issued for the occasion;
	The place where the drawings will be held and the dates and times thereof;
	The date upon which prizes will be awarded and the retail value of each;
	The non-repeating consecutive number of the ticket;
	The aggregate retail value of all prizes to be awarded;
	The price of the ticket;
	The purpose to which the entire net proceeds will be devoted;
	The statement: "No substitution of the offered prize may be made."; and
	The statement: "If gambling is a problem for you or someone in your family, Dial 1-800-GAMBLER."
	resence of the holder of the ticket shall not be required in order to win unless the ticket bears the nent "NOT VALID UNLESS HOLDER IS PRESENT AT THE DRAWING."
	The stub of each ticket shall bear the name and address of the holder, the number of the ticket, the raffle license issued for the occasion and the identification number of the licensed organization.

Note: Calendar Raffles must be held for at least 3 consecutive months and a drawing must be held at least once a week.

Sample Ticket Not Provided	Sample tickets are required when the winner of the prize does NOT NEED TO BE PRESENT at the time of the drawing and ALWAYS for Off Premise raffles.
