ORDINANCE 018-2025

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANSFIELD, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 313 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED TOWING MOST NOTABLY, SECTION 313-12, ENTITLED "FEE SCHEDULE"

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is amend and Chapter 313, Section 313-12 Fee Schedule.

WHEREAS, the Township of Mansfield created a fee schedule for the fees and rates for towing and storage of motor vehicles used by towing companies licensed by the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Code, Chapter 313, Section 12, which references fees and rates by which a licensed towing company is allowed to charge a motorist in need of such services in the Township, has been found to require updating; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to amend the fee and rate schedule by which a license towing company can charge motorists in the Township to better align with the fees imposed by surrounding municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Mansfield, County of Warren, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 313-12, Fee Schedule is hereby amended as follows:

§260-2 License; application License fees under this chapter shall be as follows:

- A. Light- duty tow service (GVW under 10,000 pounds)
 - 1. Day rate (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) shall be fixed at \$200 per vehicle towed plus any additional fees allowed within this chapter. There shall be no mileage charged from the tow location back to the tow company location. If police release said vehicle and allow it to be towed to a location agreed upon by the responsible person of the vehicle and the tow company, then from that point on the tow is no longer covered under this chapter and is at the discretion of the policies set forth by the tow company.
 - 2. Saturday/Sunday/nights/holiday rates shall be a fixed \$225 per vehicle towed plus additional fees as noted above.
- B. Medium-duty tow service (GVW 10,000 to 26,000 pounds):
 - 1. Day rate (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) shall be fixed at \$250 per hour per vehicle towed (minimum of one hour), plus any additional fees allowed within this chapter. There shall be no mileage charged from the tow location back to the tow company location. If police release said vehicle and allows to be towed to a location agreed upon by the responsible person of the vehicle and the tow company, then from that point on the tow is no longer covered under this chapter and is at the discretion of the policies set forth by the tow company.
 - 2. Saturday/Sunday/night/holiday rates shall be a fixed \$275 per hour and per vehicle towed (minimum of one hour), plus additional fees as noted above.
- C. Heavy-duty tow service (GVW over 26,000 pounds):

- 1. When a conventional wrecker can be used, the fixed daytime rate shall be \$500 per hour per vehicle towed with a one-hour minimum.
- 2. Saturday/Sunday/nights/holiday rates shall be a fixed \$550 per hour and per vehicle towed (minimum of one hour), plus additional fees as noted above.
- 3. When under-reach towing is required, the fixed hourly rate shall be \$550 with a one-hour minimum.
- 4. Saturday/Sunday/night/holiday rates shall be a fixed \$600 per hour per vehicle towed (minimum of one hour), plus additional fees as noted above.

D. Other rates for additional services:

- 1. A "day" is defined as a twenty-four period beginning at 00:01 hours. The day of the actual tow shall not be billed as a storage day.
- 2. Storage fees for vehicles shall be fixed at \$45 per day for motor vehicles under 22 feet in length and \$125 per day vehicles 22 feet in length or longer. Any standard-use type trailer (i.e. boat trailer, landscape trailer, small enclosed trailers) less than 22 feet shall be charged on its own at the same rate as standard vehicles listed herein under 22 feet.
- 3. At the request of the Police Department for a vehicle to be stored securely inside of the tow company's facility, for investigation purposes, the flat storage fee shall be \$75 per day.
- 4. Extra charge_of \$125 per hour per extra helper,
- 5. Any additional equipment/materials necessary at the scene to complete the required job shall be billed accordingly by the tow company.
- 6. At anytime an additional tow vehicle is physically needed to assist in the required job, the tow company may bill for an additional tow truck(s) at their fixed rates listed within §313-12 of this chapter.
- 7. Prior to hookup or being loaded on a flat bed of a motor vehicle, the tow operator shall present a copy of its fee schedule to the owner or operator of the vehicle. The fee schedule shall also contain the name, address, and telephone number of the towing company and a statement of the hours when the motor vehicle may be claimed.

E. Rates for Road Service shall not exceed the following:

- 1. Motor vehicles with a GVW less than 10,000 pounds: \$150 per hour day rate and \$175 per hour night rate, with one hour minimum charge, plus costs of any materials used, including but not limited to gasoline.
- 2. Motor vehicles with a GVW greater than 10,000 pounds: \$200 per hour day rate and \$225 per hour night rate, with one hour minimum charge, plus costs of any materials used, including but not limited to gasoline.

SECTION 2. Unless otherwise set forth herein, all other terms and any applicable fees set forth in Chapter 313, Towing shall be and remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the ordinance actually invalidated and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

SECTION 1. Chapter 77, Article II, Section 15 Section B is hereby amended as follows:

§77-15 Appointment and Qualifications

- 2. Is not less than 21–18 nor more than 35 years of age in the case of a new hire or 45 years of Age in the case of a lateral hire
- **SECTION 2**. Unless otherwise set forth herein, all other terms and any applicable fees set forth in Chapter 260, Peddling and Soliciting shall be and remain unchanged.
- **SECTION 3**. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4**. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the ordinance actually invalidated and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof.
