- **SECTION 2**. Unless otherwise set forth herein, all other terms and any applicable fees set forth in Chapter 77, Police Department shall be and remain unchanged.
- **SECTION 3**. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 4**. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall be limited in its effect only to that portion of the ordinance actually invalidated and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof.
- SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANSFIELD, COUNTY OF WARREN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY PROVIDING FUNDS BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AVAILABLE IN THE GENERAL CAPITAL RESERVES TO FINANCE THE PURCHASE AND OUTFITTING OF TWO POLICE VEHICLES

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the appropriation of funds from General Capital Reserves to finance the purchase and outfitting of two police vehicles

WHEREAS, the sum of \$130,000.00 is presently available in the General Capital Reserves; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested the purchase of two (2) police vehicles and the Temporary Township Chief Financial Officer has determined that such sum should be appropriated from the General Capital Reserves to be used to fund the purchase of outfitting of two (2) police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee determines it is in the best interest of the Township to utilize the said sum of \$130,000.00 in the General Capital Reserves to finance such purchase and expenditure.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Mansfield, County of Warren, State of New Jersey as follows:

- **SECTION 1**. The sum of \$130,00.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserves to be used to fund the purchase and outfitting of two (2) police vehicles.
- **SECTION 2**. The General Capital Reserves budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
- **SECTION 3**. If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence, or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.
